



Spay / Neuter Agreement

At this time all of our puppies are sold on spay / neuter contracts with limited AKC.

What does this mean?

It means that families that adopt our puppies agree and are expected to have them spayed or neutered by 2 years of age.

Our puppies' AKC registrations are limited at this time. Which means you may register them through the AKC but not breed them, any offspring that may be produced by one of our puppies will not be able to be registered.

It is the adopters responsibility to ensure the puppy they buy from us is properly secured and separated from intact dogs of the opposite gender when in season at all times. All buyers agree they will not breed our puppies intentionally or unintentionally.

Our puppies families are made aware prior to placing a deposit of our spay and neuter contract and limited registration restriction. Spay and neuter contracts and a no breeding policy is mandatory. A spay and neuter contract will be signed at pick up in your puppy's contract paperwork

Puppies are not to be spayed before 1 year of age. However, we recommend not spaying or neutering before 18 to 24 months old to allow your puppy to mature.
